



Legal Limit Values

The illness causing effects of electrosmog exposure are scientifically unchallenged. For this reason in 1996 the legislator set the threshold values in the 26. Federal Immission Control Regulation, which when adhered to, should avoid health damage.

In practice, the legal limits have not been successful as they only account for a part of the known and researched effects, the thermal effects, and other important a-thermal effects are not accounted for. Therefore, by adhering to the legal limits can also in part lead to massive orientation and health disorders.

As a result of this deficiency, building biology was forced to establish bench marks, which account for all known scientific effects and are worthwhile in practice. **If these values are exceeded, continued exposure could lead to severe damage to health.**
